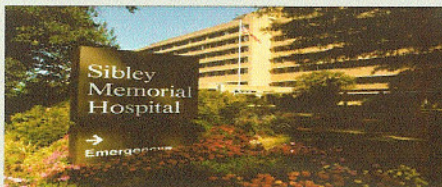
Learning Objectives
